

# Law of Corporate Finance 37023-E

### *About the course*

All firms need funding.

The funding structure of the firm and the choice of investors influence the future of the firm.

This advanced law course will focus on the fundamental legal issues of funding transactions, business acquisitions, and derivatives from the perspective of a manufacturing firm in a European context.

We will study financial contracting, international business practice and European law such as EU company law and EU financial markets law.





#### **Contents**

There will be roughly ten written lectures in period 3 with roughly the following contexts:

- The big picture setting the scene
- Internal financing, release of capital
- Debt loan facility agreements
- Debt syndicated loans and project finance
- Credit enhancements "the equity technique", "the mezzanine technique"
- Shareholders' capital ...





- Business acquisitions (1) a simple sale
- Business acquisitions (2) a listed company as the target
- Derivatives
- Legal opinions, legal due diligence
